

GOLD HILLS MEN'S CLUB MONTHLY MEETING MINUTES

MEMBERS IN ATTENDANCE: None

President Mike Parisot called the meeting to order at 5:30pm.

Secretary's Report: The Minutes from the previous meeting were approved, as is, with no changes.

Treasurer's Report: Steve and Mike met at Merchants Bank of Commerce. Board members can now access statement in "Read Only" capacity. There was a new deposit of \$740, but the updated total balance was not completed by meeting date and estimated to be around \$7,000.

OLD BUSINESS:

Total membership is now 156.

World Handicap System (WHS): Jeff Thomason and Lon Alward attended NCGA meeting @ Tierra Oaks to learn about new system. Begins Jan 1, but blackout period for transition is Jan 1-5. Scores can be posted on Jan 6th, max index is 54.0 but can be set lower for tournaments. Net Double-Bogey is the new max score on any hole for posting purposes (ESC). Gold Hills GC has future plans to re-rate the handicaps of each hole.

Handicap: Board voted to allow 24 hours to post a score after play, will require Lon to check tee sheets daily for compliance. If non-compliance is found, penalty will be an additional posting of 1 (one) lowest differential score.

Rules: Board discussed Hero World Challenge PGA tournament where Patrick Reed was assessed a 2-stroke penalty for improving his lie in a waste bunker, not grounding his club in a sand trap.

Tournament: 2020 Tournament schedule was passed out and posted on bulletin boards. Board discussed getting sponsors for major tournaments. Board decided to eliminate the Gold Cup.

Member Planet Portal/Club Ambassador: Due to a required annual fee, Board decided we will NOT be part of the Member Planet Portal.

Other: Jeff T. said the NCGA will continue to send out handicap listing on the 1st & 15th of each month. Also, GH will use a golfer's handicap for both days of a 2-day tournament, even if a handicap changes overnight.

NEW BUSINESS:

Motion PASSED to allow local PGA pros to participate in our Club Championship. BUT... if they win, they will not be allowed to play at the Pro/Am tournament at the next stage.

Discussed trying to get Hole-In-One insurance and how it would be implemented. Mike was going to speak with Paula about including it in the monthly dues. Members will have the option of opting out, and outside play will not be eligible for insurance.
